That are daily actions reflect our goal of good discipleship.

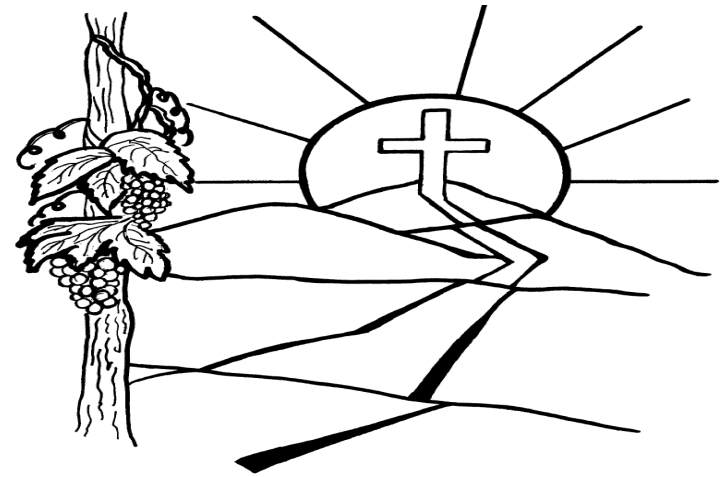
